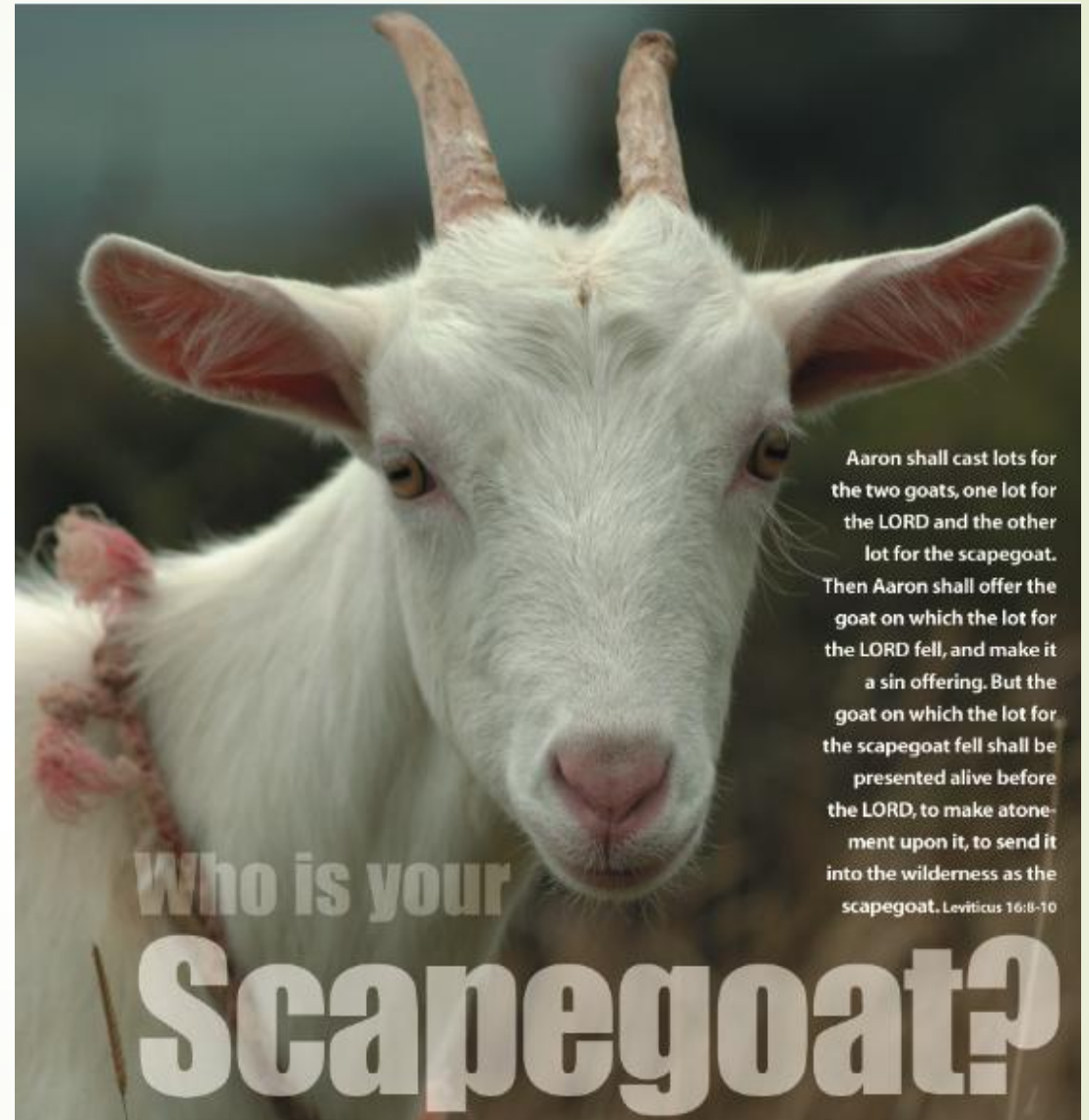
What is a Scapegoat?
