

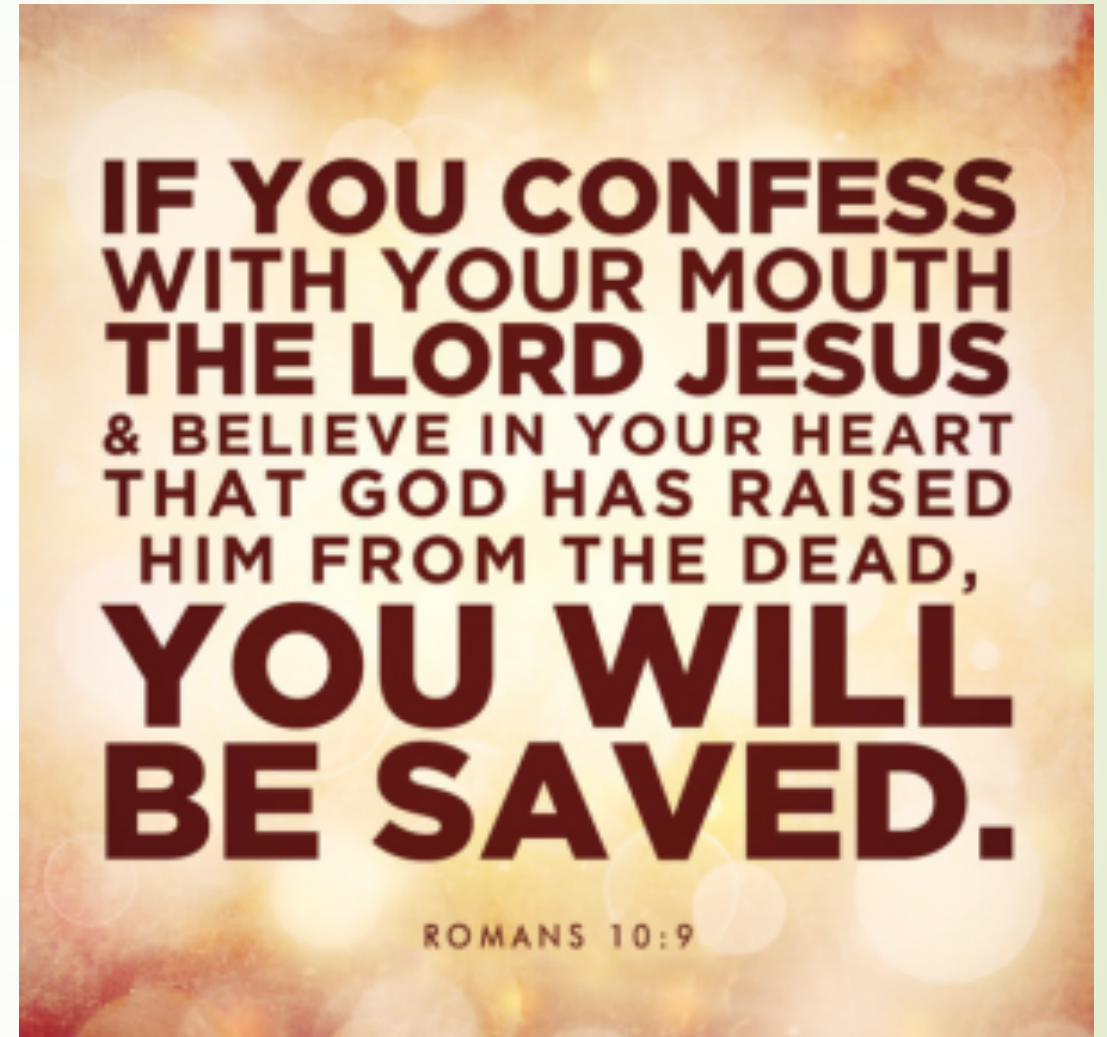


Confession made unto Salvation

Romans 10:8 – 13

Defining the term:

- In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word for *confess* or *make confession* is *yadah*.
- The word used in the New Testament for *confess* is the Greek word *homologeo*, which is a compound word using the words *homo* (same) and *logeo* (speak).
- James 3:5 – 10

 - ▶ Romans 1:16 – 17

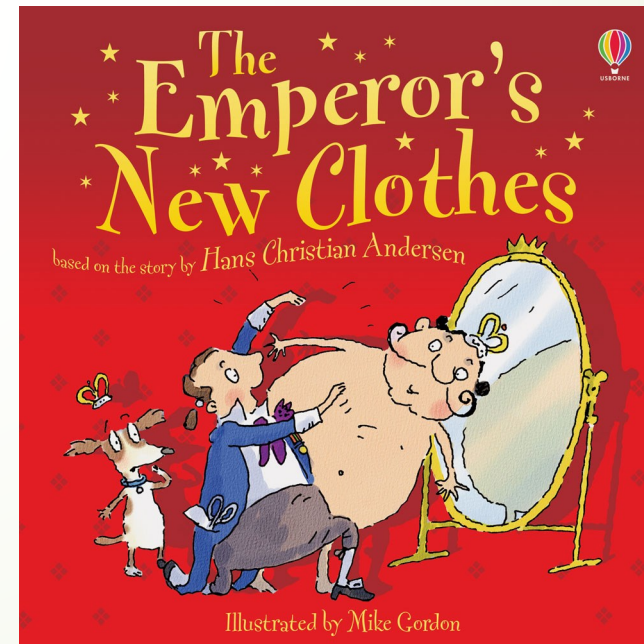


The Four Acts of Confession
