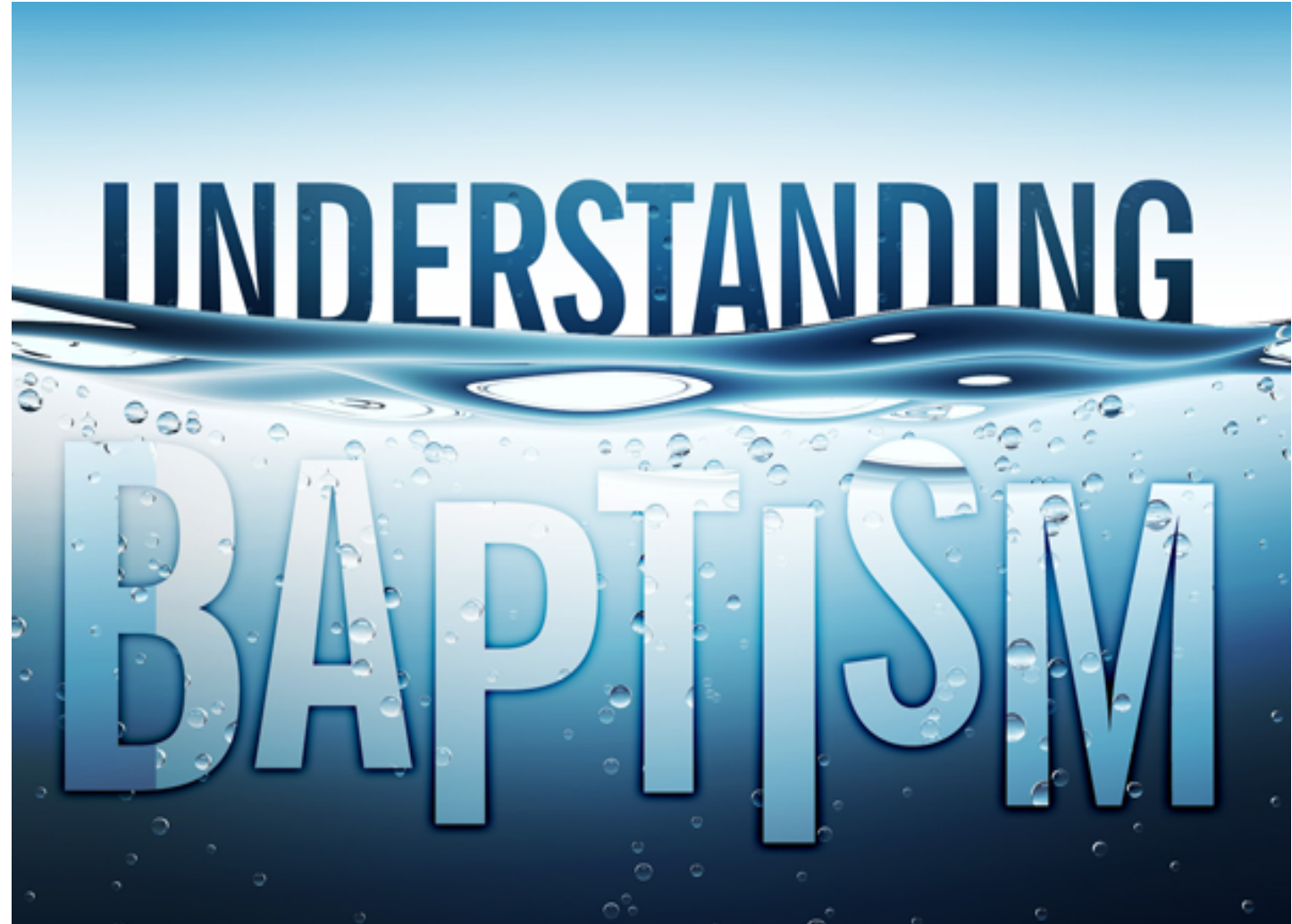


Is it really necessary to be baptized for Salvation?

Defining the term:

- In the New Testament, the word *baptism* is from the Greek word *baptismos* and *baptize* is from the Greek *baptizo*.

Why is baptism important?

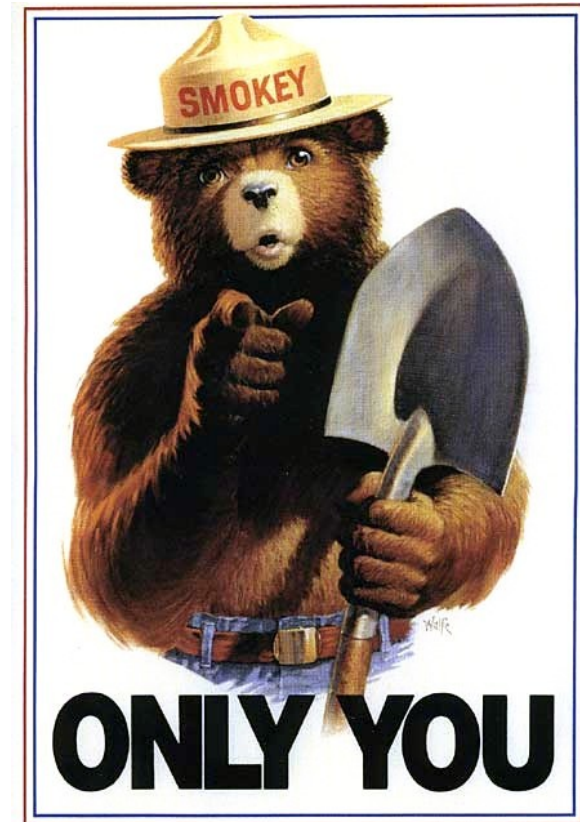
- ▶ **We are “baptized into Christ Jesus”.**
