

Defining the term:

- Our English word derives from a Latin root (spir) related to breathing (spiro), the wind, or the spirit/Spirit (spiritus).
- In this way it corresponds very closely to the Greek word pneuma and its cognates, or the Hebrew word ruah.
- In the KJV, the word inspiration appears twice, once in the Old Testament and once in the New.
