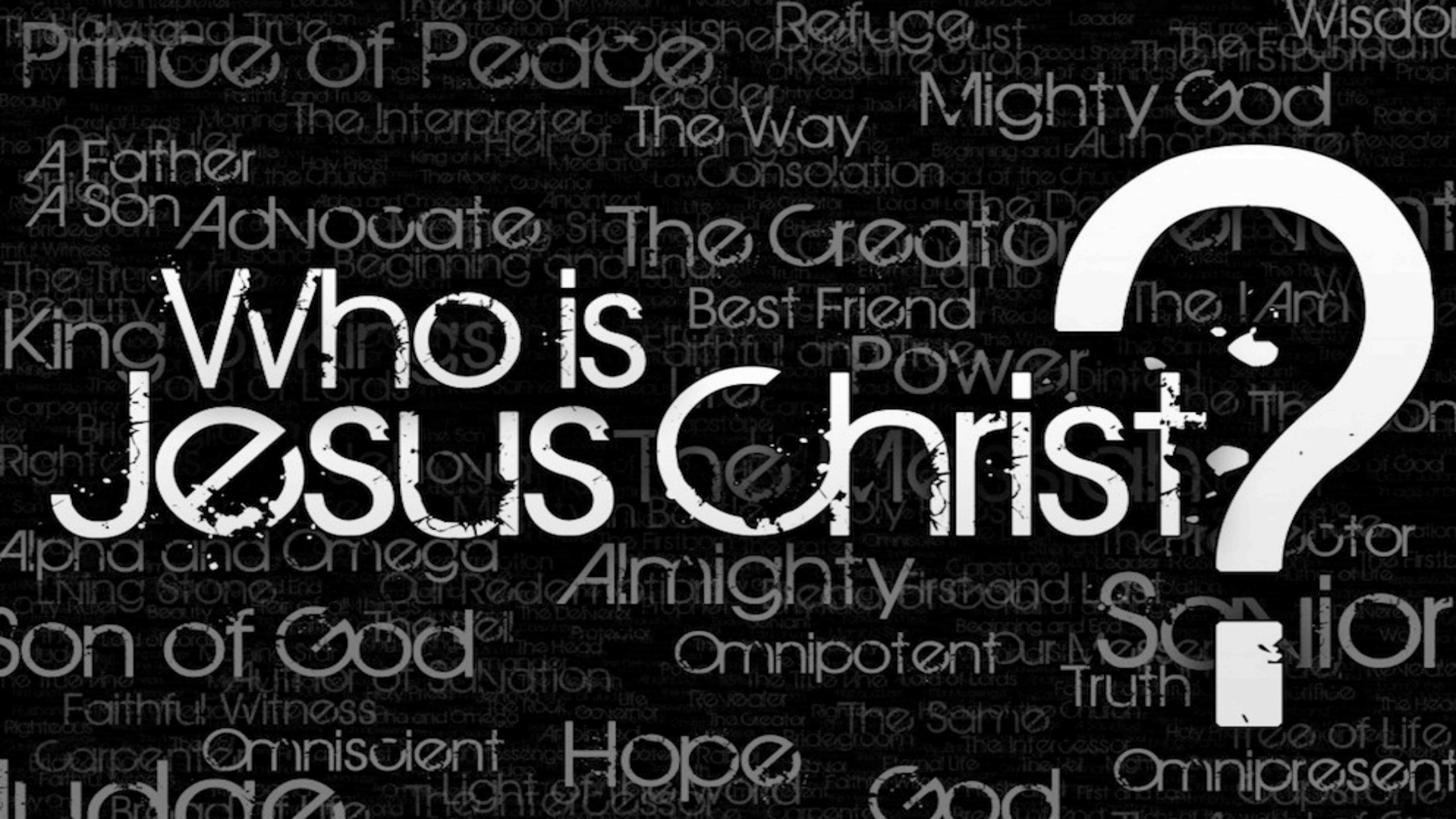

## Defining the term:

- The word *Christ* comes from the Greek word *Christós*, which is itself a translation of the Hebrew *Mašîaḥ*, a word that is transliterated in the KJV as “Messiah.”
- The literal English meaning of both the Greek and Hebrew words is “the Anointed One.”

- **Recognizing the identity of Jesus as the *Christós* brings a blessing.**
  - 1 Corinthians 1:18 – 31
  - Ephesians 1:3
  - Galatians 3:26 – 29
- **It is the appropriate response to the revelation of God.**
  - Jesus was the fulfillment of Prophecy concerning the coming Christ.
    - Luke 24:13 – 27
    - There are more than 300 Messianic prophecies in the O.T.
    - Acts 2:22 – 36
  - Jesus' miracles confirmed His anointing from God to be the Christ.
    - Luke 7:18 – 23
    - John 4:25 – 30
    - John 20:30 – 31
- **The confession of Jesus as the Christ forms the foundation for the church.**
