




JOHN 6 – JESUS FEEDS A MULTITUDE





JOHN 6 – THE PEOPLE ARE TEMPORARILY SATISFIED





JOHN 6 – THE CROWD SEEKS JESUS





JOHN 6 – JESUS TEACHES ON SOUL FOOD





WHAT IS THAT NEED AND WHAT CAUSED **IT**?


HUNGRY, THIRSTY AND EMPTY SOULS


He has made everything beautiful in its time. **He has also set eternity in the human** heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end. – Ecclesiates 3:11

JOHN 6 – JESUS TEACHES ON SOUL FOOD





WE ARE A SPIRIT WITH A BODY

- For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. – Romans 8:5-8

THE BREAD OF LIFE?

HUNGRY, THIRSTY AND EMPTY SOULS




- The PROBLEM with the flesh

The BODY IS DYING

- It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. – John 6:63
- Therefore we do not lose heart. <u>Though</u> <u>outwardly we are wasting away</u>, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. – 2 Corinthians 4:16
