

## Five Points of Calvinism (TULIP)

- Total Depravity: through Adam and Eve's fall, every person is born sinful
- Unconditional Election: God "saves" those he wishes; concept of predestination
- Limited Atonement: Jesus died for the chosen only, not for everyone.
- Irresistible Grace: God's grace is given freely; it cannot be earned or denied
- Perseverance of the "saints": those elected by God have full power to interpret the will of God

The doctrine of total depravity is central to the rest of Calvinistic doctrine.

#### **ESV Romans 5:13-14**

for sin indeed was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not counted where there is no law. Yet death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those whose sinning was not like the transgression of Adam, who was a type of the one who was to come.

**ESV** Romans 5:18-19 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

#### What are the implications of the inherited sin doctrine?

- We bear the guilt of sinful action we took no part in.
- We cannot do anything that pleases the Lord God.
  - Romans 8:7 8 (ESV) (7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. 8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.)
- Babies are born guilty of sin. Therefore, when a child dies passes away, he or she is doomed to be condemned in Hell.
- Jesus, being born in the flesh, would have inherited sin as well as the rest of mankind.

# We must understand the difference between guilt and consequences.

"What do you mean by repeating this proverb concerning the land of Israel, 'The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge'? As I live, declares the Lord God, this proverb shall no more be used by you in Israel.

~ Ezekiel 18:2-3

## Behold, all souls are mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is mine: the soul who sins shall die.

~ Ezekiel 18:4 ESV

The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not suffer for the iniquity of the father, nor the father suffer for the iniquity of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.
