AND EVERY TONGUE SHALL GIVE PRAISE TO GOD.”

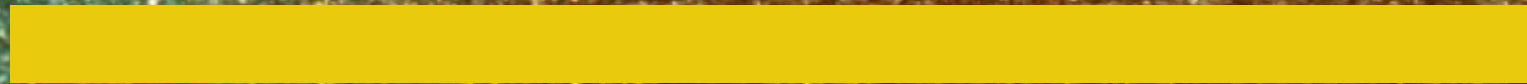




Ephesians 1:7...
