Peter – God approved “Repentance”

 - Luke 22:31 – 34
 - John 13:36 – 38
- Peter’s Denial:
 - Matthew 26:69 – 75
 - Mark 14:66 – 72
 - Luke 22:54 – 62
 - John 18:15 – 18
 - John 18:25 – 27
- Peter’s Repentance:
 - John 21:15 – 19

Judas – Manmade “Sorrow”

- Matthew 26:14 – 16
- Matthew 27:3 – 10


What is Sorrow?

- “It is used of a change of mind, such as to produce regret or even remorse on account of sin, but not necessarily a change of heart. This word is used with reference to the repentance of Judas (Matt. 27:3).”
- 2 Corinthians 7:10

What is Repentance?

- “to change one's mind and purpose, as the result of after knowledge”
- Matthew 21:28 – 32
