²⁰always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.



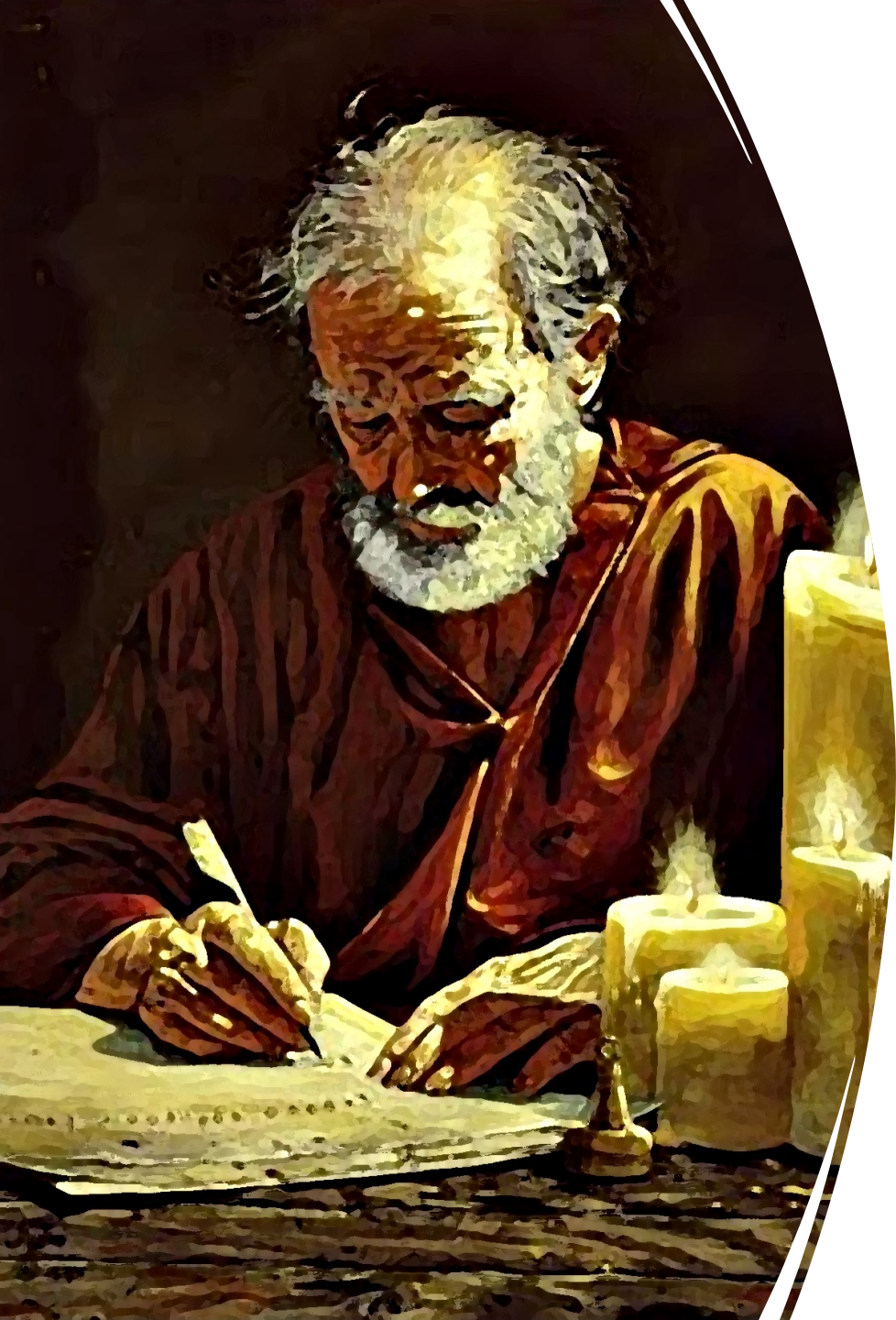
2 Timothy 3:1-5

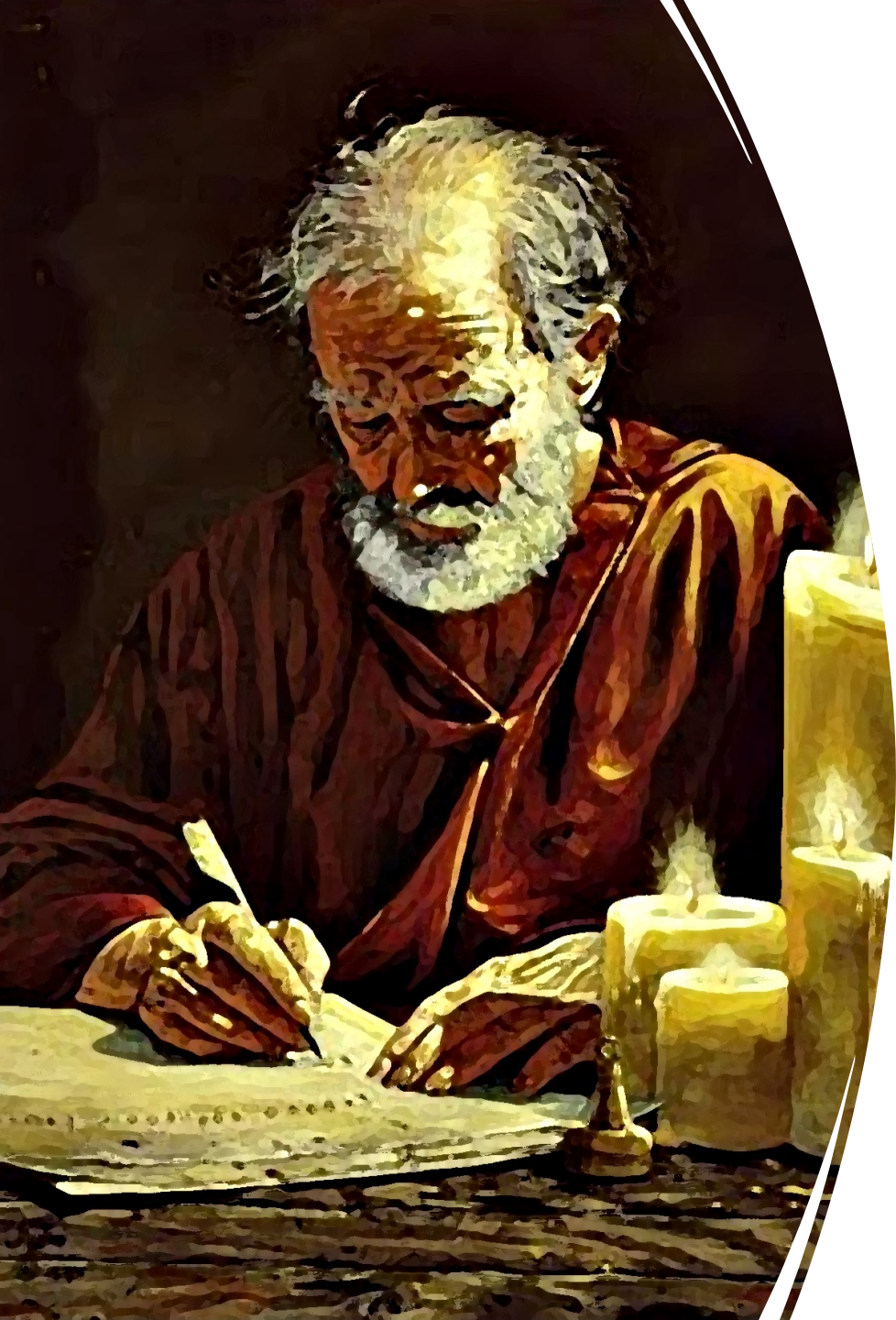
