Is the church of Christ a denomination?

Definitions of a Denomination:

- Webster's online dictionary:
 - an act of denominating the denomination of prices in U.S. dollars
 - a value or size of a series of values or sizes metric denominations;
 - name, designation;
 - a religious organization whose congregations are united in their adherence to its beliefs and practices people from several different Christian denominations
- The Cambridge online Dictionary defined denomination as:
 - a religious group whose beliefs differ in some ways from other groups in the same religion.

Characteristics of a Denominational Church:

- Denominations have a founder, other than Jesus.
- Denominations have an earthly head (conference or board).
- Denominations have a creed that has been established by its conference or board.
- Denominations have the name of its founder or practice.
- Denominations have an elaborate hierarchy (organization).
- Denominations have traditional creed of worship.
- Denominations have a list of mandatory requirements for membership into the organization.
