The Challenging Accusations & Questions we are looking at in this study:


- Does the church of Christ believe that Christians are saved by grace?

- Romans 4:1 – 8
 - Romans 3:31
 - Hebrews 10:1 – 4
 - Genesis 26:1 – 5
 - James 2:21 – 24
- Ephesians 2:8 – 10
 - Notice the Context:
 - Ephesians 2:1 – 7
 - Ephesians 2:11 – 16
 - There is a difference between “earning something” and “obedience”!
 - Hebrews 5:7 – 10
