




Answering Challenging Questions:

cover all of our sin?

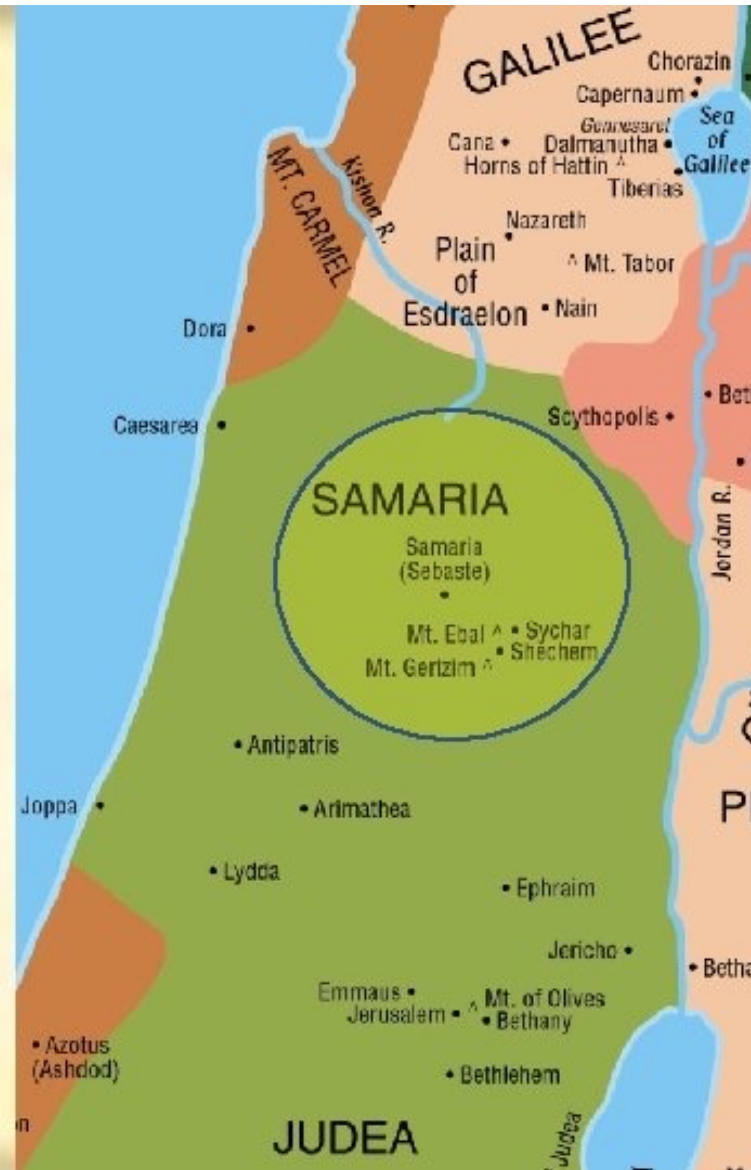

Let's look at the example of Simon's fall from grace.

Simon the Sorcerer Believes (Acts 8:9-17)

- Simon had a great following among the people because of his sorcery.
- But the people believed Philip's preaching about Jesus and the kingdom, and they had been baptized.
- Simon also believed and was baptized.
- He was amazed at the signs and miracles done by Philip
- When Peter & John came to Samaria, they imparted the miraculous measure of the Holy Spirit to believers.



Can a Christian fall from God's grace and back into a sinful situation?


