Is Thy Heart Right With God?



Is = Present Tense



Thy = Your Heart



Heart = That part where you exercise an act of will.



Blessed are those who keep His testimonies,

Who seek Him with the whole heart!

Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

Right = An absolute objective standard



He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

With God = the ultimate being of love, justice, mercy, and power.





1. The Heart That is Right With God Will be a Heart that Has a **Righteous Focus**.

And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."

Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.'³⁸ This is the first and great commandment.


And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'





Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.


If then you were raised with Christ,
