New York City: Laura Jeanne Miller, 57, formerly of Brighton died suddenly of a brain aneurysm on July 30, 2016. A graduate of Columbia University School of Business and Carleton College, a job in her youth selling seeds to feed & grain stores helped focus her dreams towards a marketing MBA and a marketing directorship at a great museum in New York City. She achieved that dream following a time at American

Express, joining the Guggenheim Museum twenty-one years ago. A triathlete as well as an art-lover, she was herself most impressed by her young son Jesse's striving to find and pursue his own life's course.

Born in Rochester, NY, Laura graduated from Brighton High School. Laura enjoyed photographing third world markets and completed more studio art courses than required for a BFA in a modestly successful attempt at painting those intense beauties, her memories, and imaginative fictions. She spoke internationally on museum branding and marketing always returned home with good chocolate and gifts of indigenous art and taught her expertise at NYU. A prolonged midwinter furnace problem in student housing once caused her to adopt as her own an aphorism she had learned from a renowned eccentric aunt: "Never deny yourself the luxury of long underwear!" She repeated it often when someone complained about the cold or otherwise suggested that life was too restrained by some natural circumstance. Nine strangers' lives have suddenly improved, she might be happy to know, because of her plan to donate organs at death.

**WHETHER YOU'RE TAKING DRUGS

CHEMICAL

You over-expose the brain with pleasure chemicals like dopamine, serotonin, oxytocin and epinephrine.



REWIRING

Your brain ewires itself to accommodate the extra chemicals.

DEPENDENCY

You build up a tolerance and a dependency to the chemicals. You go from "wanting" the pleasure chemicals in order to feel good, to "needing" them.

Frontal Lobes

The area of your brain responsible for making decisions and logically thinking through situations and scenarios is the part of your brain most affected by addiction.
