




How can I know that I'm saved?




- Mark 16:15 – 16 (ESV) (15 And he said to them, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. 16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.)
- John 20:30 – 31 (ESV) (30 Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.)

- Romans 10:17 (ESV) (17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.)
- Hebrews 11:1 (ESV) (1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.)
- Hebrews 11:6 (ESV) (6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.)




- James 2:21 – 24 (ESV) (*21 Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up his son Isaac on the altar? 22 You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works; 23 and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, “Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness”—and he was called a friend of God. 24 You see that a person is justified by works and not by faith alone.*)

- Acts 17:30 – 31 (ESV) (30 *The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent, 31 because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.*)
- Acts 2:37 – 38 (ESV) (37 *Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Brothers, what shall we do?” 38 And Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.)*


How can I know that I'm saved?




- Matthew 10:32 – 33 (ESV) (32 So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, 33 but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven.)
- Romans 10:10 (NKJV) (10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.)

Acts 8:35 – 38 (ESV) (35 Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus. 36 And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, “See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?” 37 And Philip said, “If you believe with all your heart, you may.” And he replied, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.” 38 And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him.)




Mark 16:15 – 16 (ESV) (*15 And he said to them, “Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation. 16 Whoever believes and **is baptized will be saved**, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.*)

1 Peter 3:20 – 21 (ESV) (20 because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. 21 Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,)




How can I know that I'm saved?
