The Nelson Mandela Effect

The “**Nelson Mandela Effect**” (sometimes mistakenly called the *Mandala effect*) refers to a phenomenon where large groups of people remember an event, fact, or detail differently from how it actually occurred.

Famous Examples of the Mandela Effect:

- **Berenstain Bears** – Many remember it as *Berenstein Bears*.
- **Star Wars** – The line is “No, I am your father,” not “Luke, I am your father.”
- **Snow White** – The Queen says, “Magic mirror on the wall,” not “Mirror, mirror on the wall.”
- **Looney Tunes** – It’s spelled *Looney Tunes*, not *Looney Toons*.
- **Febreze** – The brand has one “e” in the middle, not *Febreeze*.
- **Monopoly Man** – People recall him with a monocle, but he never had one.
- **Fruit of the Loom** – Many think there was a cornucopia behind the fruit logo, but there never was.

Common Biblical Mandela Effect Examples:

- What kind of fruit did Adam and Eve eat in the Garden of Eden?
 - Genesis 2:9; 3:1 – 6
 - The word “apple” is found 11 times in the Bible but not once in the Garden of Eden.
- What took Elijah up into Heaven?
 - 2 Kings 2:1 – 12
- Who was the uncle of Esther?
 - Esther 2:5 – 7
- Who was the wife of Samson? Who cut Samson’s hair?
 - Judges 16:4 – 22

- Who told Joseph and Mary there was “no room at the inn”?
 - Luke 2:1 – 7
- How many wisemen came to visit Jesus? How many gifts did they bring?
 - Matthew 2:1 – 12
- How old was Jesus when the wise men visited? Where did they visit him?
 - Matthew 2:1 – 12, 16
